**Location:** The Seminary is located at Matigara, Siliguri, West Bengal, India. It is in a very convenient location, just 3 kilometres from the City Centre, 12 kilometres from Bagdogra Airport, 14 kilometres from New Jalpaiguri Railway station and 6 kilometres from bus terminus and Railway Junction, Siliguri. Siliguri is situated at the beautiful foothills of Darjeeling, "The Queen of Hills." It is surrounded by the neighbouring countries Bhutan, Nepal, Bangladesh, and Tibet-China. The Seminary provides students with impressive natural beauties like snow-capped, Himalayan Ranges and lustrous tea-gardens. The Seminary has a beautiful campus in four acres land. It provides a calm and pleasant atmosphere for its inhabitant.

**Academic Year:** The Seminary academic year begins from the 2nd week of June and ends by the 2nd week of April. The whole academic year is divided into two semesters.
